The management of the company announced today that effective October 1, 2005, the corporate office and printed circuit board assembly manufacturing operations will be re-located to a new facility in Farmington NY.

At approximately that same time, the manufacturing space leased by Badger Technologies at the Ultralife Batteries facility in Newark NY will also be re-opened to manufacture products dedicated solely to Ultralife.

The cable and wire harness assembly operation will continue to remain in Penn Yan, NY.

The reasons for this transition are many, and not limited to the following:

- The lack of adequate available space, in quantity and type, at the current location is a hindrance to company growth
- The inability to attract sufficient qualified management and technical staff to work at the current location
- Improved proximity to a potential customer base that needs to be developed in order to provide sales growth

It is the company's intent to have positions for all current employees at one of the three operational locations. The reorganization is expected to initially generate approximately 20 - 30 new jobs at the Newark NY facility and 75 total jobs in Farmington NY, 25 of them will be new hires.
